

Brighton Park Residents – As pool season has begun, we thought this would be a good time to remind all of our HOA pool rules along with a Code of Conduct regarding the pool area.

Brighton Park Pool Rules & Regulations

- In Case of Emergency call 9-1-1
- Brighton Park pools are for Residents and Guests of residents only – Trespassers will be prosecuted
- If people enter the pool other than during pool open hours or are not residents of the community call the police at 757-382-6161
- Pool hours are from 9:00 AM through 10:00 PM
- Do not use pools if you are ill or have open wounds
- Diaper changing in the pool or deck area is prohibited
- No pets are allowed in the pool or pool area
- Smoking is prohibited in the pool area.
- Children under the age of 16 are not allowed in the pool area unless supervised by an accompanying adult
- No Diving allowed in pool
- No running in pool area
- No glass containers are allowed in the pool area
- No bicycles, scooters, or skateboards are allowed to be used in the pool area
- Do not open pool gate for anyone who does not have a pool access key card
- Pool Capacity is 35 persons

Brighton Park Pool Code of Conduct

- Be respectful of the pool area and others enjoying the pool area
- If you make trash in the pool area, put the trash in the garbage can in the area.
- Please make sure umbrellas are closed after using them
- Close restroom doors and shut lights in restrooms after using
- If you use the restroom, please make sure to leave it clean for the next persons.
- When entering or leaving the pool area please make sure gate is closed
- Do not open pool gate for individuals trying to access the pool and not with your group.

By following the above everyone can have an enjoyable experience at our pools and keep the costs to the HOA down. If we take care of our pool areas then items will not need to be replaced or repaired and will help keep our HOA fees reasonable. This directly affects each and every one of us!
